Coyne appointed to Health, Environment committees

STATE HOUSE – Sen. Cynthia A. Coyne (D-Dist. 32, Barrington, Bristol, East Providence) will serve on the Senate Health and Human Services Committee and its Environment and Agriculture Committee, President of the Senate M. Teresa Paiva Weed announced this week.



The Health and Human Services Committee considers legislation and matters dealing with the Department of Health, the Department of Human Services and the Department of Behavioral Healthcare, Developmental Disabilities and Hospitals. It also handles legislation relative to public health and welfare; health care and human service access and quality, professional standards of practice and facility standards of care.

The Environment and Agriculture Committee considers all legislation and matters relating to the conservation of the air, land, water, plant, animal, mineral and other natural resources of the state.

Senator Coyne served on the Barrington Town Council from 2010 to 2014. She is a retired state trooper and now works as administrative supervisor for Johnson & Wales University's Department of Safety & Security and as a certified assessor for the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc.
